

Annual Report for the Period Nov'03-Nov'04

One more year passes by and it is heartening to note that our activities and commitments have grown over the year. Presented below are the details of the activities undertaken by the Trust during the above-mentioned period.

Achievements:

The main activities during the past one year have been focused in three locations namely Pannamayee Sisihu Niketan, Burdhan; Sri Ramakrishna Sevashrama, Dakshin Durgapur and Phoolbagan, Bolpur. The areas of work have been mainly health and education for the poor and the needy. The project wise details are as follows:

- **Education (PSN)**

Since January 2004 NMCT has associated itself with Pannamayee Sidhu Niketan (PSN). PSN is a home for orphans and destitutes presently sheltering 13 children. It has been providing financial assistance for education and entertainment of the children of the Niketan and so far donated around **Rs.10,377/-** in cash and kind. The Trust has been sponsoring the cost of employing two teachers for the inmates of the home, one each for studies and music at a monthly salary of Rs.400/- each.

- **Free Medical Camp (PSN)**

A free medical camp was conducted by the Trust from the premises of PSN for the economically backward people of the adjoining locality on the 28th of March 2004. A team of 5 doctors treated a total of 251 patients. The cost of which came to around **Rs.8,813.50/-**. Medicines worth Rs.4257/- along with free medicines donated by East India Pharmaceuticals Ltd. were donated for the purpose.

- **Orphan Welfare (SRS)**

The Trust has been working for welfare of the children of Sri Ramakrishna Sevashrama (SRS), Dakshin Durgapur for the past 7 months. SRS is a home for orphans and destitutes presently sheltering 50 odd children. While the home also runs a school upto class IV for the children of the home, the children attend the local government school from class V onwards. The Trust has sponsored acrylic plastic sheets for windowpanes for protection from sun and rain in the school and residential building in SRS. The cost of the same came to Rs.4650/- . In addition to the above the Trust has also donated medicines, clothes and cash for the welfare of these orphans of the ashrama.

- **Free Medical Camp (CIHD)**

Since October last the Trust has been working with Centre for Integrated Human Development (CIHD), Bolpur for the welfare of the villagers of the tribal village Phoolbagan, Illambazar. A free medical camp was conducted in Phoolbagan on the 3rd October 2004. A team of two doctors treated a total of 57 patients providing them with free medicines, which included 19 male, 38 female, 36 adult and 21 children of which 12 children were below 5 years of age. It has been decided that similar camps would be conducted in the village on quarterly basis for the villagers of Phoolbagan and its three adjoining tribal villages. It has also been decided that follow-up medical clinics would be organized on fortnightly/monthly basis.

- **Other Helps Rendered by the Trust**

Besides the above mentioned projects undertaken by the trust, the trust also rendered help to two needy and the poor students. The Trust has continued the educational support rendered to Mridul Das as mentioned in the last annual report. In addition the Trust has also provided financial support to Debanjan Das by paying his college fees.

- **Additional Commitments For The Year 2004-05:** In addition to the above mentioned activities it has been decided that the following activities would be undertaken during the current financial year:

Nayantara Memorial Charitable Trust

(Reg. No.: 4056 of 2002 & 4905 of 2003)

1. Installing playing items such as swing, slip etc. for the children of Sri Ramakrishna Sevashrama (SRS), Dakshin Durgapur such as Swing and Slip and donating sports goods like Volleyball, Ring etc.
2. Starting a free out-door-clinic for the villagers of the adjoining villages of SRS;
3. Sinking a tube well to ensure clean drinking water for the inmates of SRS;
4. Starting a Pre-Primary school for the children of Phoolbagan.

Further I would like to bring to the notice of all the members that Kabiraj & Co. of Chartered Accountants was reappointed the official auditors of the trust. The accounts of the trust for the financial year 2003-2004 were duly prepared and audited by Kabiraj & Co. of Chartered Accountants the report whereof is being tabled along with this report as Annexure I.

While presenting this report in the annual general meeting of the trust I would like to appeal to all the members of the trust to come out with constructive ideas that would help the trust to perform in a better way and achieve the objectives with which the trust has been formed. Last but not the least I would like to thank all the well-wishers, patrons and members of the Trust for all the help they have been rendering.
