

## **Report for the Period Nov'04-Jan'06**

Presented below are the details of the activities undertaken by the Trust during the above-mentioned period.

### **Achievements:**

The main activities during the past one year have been focused in three locations namely Pannamayee Sisihu Niketan, Burdhan; Sri Ramakrishna Sevashrama, Dakshin Durgapur and Phoolbagan, Bolpur. The areas of work have been mainly health and education for the poor and the needy. The project wise details are as follows:

- **Education (PSN)**

Since January 2004 NMCT has associated itself with Pannamayee Sidhu Niketan (PSN). PSN is a home for orphans and destitutes presently sheltering 13 children. It has been providing financial assistance for education and entertainment of the children of the Niketan and in the last one year the Trust has donated around **Rs.9,600/-** in cash and kind. The Trust has been sponsoring the cost of employing two teachers for the inmates of the home, one each for studies and music at a monthly salary of Rs.400/- each.

- **Free Homeopathy Clinic (PSN)**

A free homeopathy clinic has been started since July 2005. The clinic is conducted from the premises of PSN twice a week. Medicines worth **Rs.12,708/-** has been donated for the purpose.

- **Free Homeopathy Clinic (Phoolbagan and Rangabandh)**

Since January the Trust has been conducting free weekly homeopathy clinic in the village of Phoolbagan and similar facility has been started in the village of Rangabandh since September 2005. Medicines worth **Rs.10,877/-** has been donated for the purpose.

- **Free Medical Camp (Phoolbagan)**

A free medical camp was conducted by the Trust at Phoolbagan of Illambazar on the 4<sup>th</sup> January 2005. A team of 2 doctors treated a total of 57 patients.

- **Drinking Water Project in Illambazar**

Three tubewells have been installed in the villages of Bansuli, Panskura and Phoolbagan costing around **Rs.77,000/-**.

- **Community Kitchen Garden (Illambazar)**

The Trust has been running a free Pre-School for the children in the age group of 2 to 6 years in the village of Phoolbagan since January 2005. Another similar school has been started in Bansuli from 1<sup>st</sup> December 2005 on persistent demand from the villagers.

- **Free Pre-School(Illambazar)**

A free medical camp was conducted by the Trust at Phoolbagan of Illambazar on the 4<sup>th</sup> January 2005. A team of 2 doctors treated a total of 57 patients.

- **Orphan Welfare (SRS)**

The Trust has been working for welfare of the children of Sri Ramakrishna Sevashrama (SRS), Dakshin Durgapur since April 2004. SRS is a home for orphans and destitutes presently sheltering 50 odd children. While the home also runs a school upto class IV for the children of the home, the children attend the local government school from class V onwards. The Trust has been providing medicines for the children and has partially sponsored the cost of two solar lanterns with a contribution of 6,000/-

- **Other Helps Rendered by the Trust**

Besides the above mentioned projects undertaken by the trust, the trust also rendered help to Debangan with his college fees and purchase of books.. The Trust had continued the educational support rendered to Mridul Das as mentioned in the last annual report till his higher secondary exams in April 2005.

- **Annual Sport in Illambazar**

The Annual Sport and Cultural function for the tribal villages was organized by Nayantara Memorial Charitable Trust on the 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> of November 2005 in the village of Bansuli. A committee comprising of the representatives from the villages of Bansuli, Rangabandh, Panskura, Phoolbagan and Bagan Para was formed to organize and conduct the sports.
